





In a surprising twist, Jackson began his career as a **caddy** at a Country Club, and here's the kicker—it's the same







Dani shares her favorite memory from Camp OUTdoors, involving Susie Camper, a camper turned member. staff From а transformative moment in 2014. where Susie, then not fully out, experienced the joy of makeup with experimentation cabin counselors, to her return in 2019 as a proud and out makeup artist glamming up her former counselor. "...you helped me put makeup on for the first time when you were my cabin counselor, and now, I'm doing your makeup." The full-circle moment reached its peak in July when Susie returned as Camp Staff, showcasing her exceptional leadership and makeup skills.

Camp OUTdoors stands as a testament to the positive impact it has on LGBTQ+ youth, creating a supportive environment that transcends the camp experience.
